

Conditions of The Competition

1. The Championship

- a. The Championship shall be open to U16s boy & girl amateur golfers of all nationalities. (Girls Red, Boys White tees.)
- b. It shall be played over 36 holes of stroke play on one day. The winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie, there will be a sudden death play-off over holes to be decided by the Championship Committee.
- c. i. 60 players shall play in the Championship.
ii. Ballot: If entries exceed 60, they shall be reduced to 60 by eliminating the higher handicaps by ballot or in such a way as the Championship Committee shall determine. Players eliminated by ballot will be kept on a reserve list. If players are not subsequently offered a place or are unable to accept such an offer, entry fees will be returned.
- d. Players may use caddies, who must be under the age of 18 at 00:00hrs on 1st January of the year in which the Championship is played. Penalty for breach of Condition: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round: four strokes.

2. Entry Qualification

Entrants must be:

- a. Under the age of 16 at 00:00hrs on 1st January of the year in which the Championship is to be played.
- b. In possession of a 'competition' handicap not exceeding 12.4 under the CONGU Unified Handicapping System or a comparable scheme operated by a recognised overseas Golf Union, Federation or Association. Entrants holding both a CONGU and an overseas authority's handicap must enter the Championship using their CONGU handicap. Failure to enter in accordance with this Condition will result in entry being denied.

3. Exemptions

Irrespective of handicap, players who finished in the top 3 places in the GGU U16s Boys and winner of the GLCGA U16s Girls Championship, (if held).

4. Winner and Prizes

- a. The winner shall be presented with the Trophy at the Prize Presentation. Prize vouchers shall be awarded to the top five places. (The trophy will be retained by the GGU.)

Note: The above conditions of competition must be read in conjunction with:

- I. Gloucestershire Golf Union's General Conditions.
- II. Gloucestershire Golf Union's "Hard Card" (Standard Local Rules, Conditions of Competition, Regulations and Safety Advice) both of which apply to this Golf Championship.

Conditions of Play and Qualifications

1. Conditions

36 hole U16s scratch stroke play Competition open to both girls and boys and played in accordance with the R&A Rules of Golf. In the event of a tie, the Competition shall be decided by 'sudden death' stroke play, play off. The first player to win a hole outright shall be the winner. (See full conditions.)

2. Prizes

Prizes will be given in the form of vouchers for the top five places.

3. Entries

Entries will be limited to 60 entries with handicaps of 12.4 or below (including the boys who finish in the first 3 places of the GGU U16s Championship played in May, regardless of handicap and the girl winner of the GLCGA U16s Championship, if held). Entries will be accepted in order of handicap. In the event of more than 60 entries being received, there will be a ballot for the last place/s between those of the lowest exact handicap not already accepted.

4. Entry Forms

6. Entry Fee

8. Start Times
