



How can your club become a Women in Golf Charter signatory?

We have created a step-by-step guide for clubs and counties to become a Charter signatory

1. [Download and read the toolkit](#) and pass it to others in the organisation who may be interested.
2. Register your interest in becoming a Women in Golf Charter signatory via the [Women in Golf Charter registration form](#). England Golf will organise for localised support through our [Club Support Officers and Partnership Managers](#).
3. Start to formulate your club commitments for the Women in Golf Charter using the Charter template we will send you. We have also prepared some examples of [Charter action plans and commitments](#) to help you formulate your own.
 - a. You can choose as many commitments as you want. All you will need to do is assign timescales and tangible measures to each commitment.
 - b. Any commitments you do make need to link back to your club/county business plan.
 - c. Under the section of 'current situation' of the action plan please include baseline figures where possible to ensure you can measure success.
4. Recruit a Charter champion, male or female, who will support and monitor the commitments and act as a main point of contact. We have created a [role descriptor for the Charter champion](#) which you can download.



5. Once you have completed a first draft, share this with your Club Support Officer or Partnership Manager and they will support you to finalise your Charter.
6. Once signed off, upload a copy of your finalised Charter to your club/county website and share the link with us so we can upload to the England Golf website. You will be able to see the [current list of signatories](#) online.
7. We recommend clubs and counties share the commitments with their membership to gain their support.
8. To support you in the activation of your commitments, use the editable assets provided on [The R&A Resource Portal](#).
9. Our CSOs and PMs will support your club or county in activating your commitments.
10. England Golf will send you a certificate and branding for your club or county to upload onto your website to demonstrate your Charter signatory status.
