TERMS OF THE COMPETITION & FURTHER INFORMATION.

1. Qualifications: The Midlands North Queen of Clubs is open to female golfers who are members of one of the following County Associations: Derbyshire, Leicestershire & Rutland, Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire, Shropshire, and Staffordshire, who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current R&A Rules Limited and who hold a current Handicap Index. Entrants must be the Club Champion of an Affiliated Golf Club within the Midlands North Region, as above, at the closing date for entries which is 26th July 2021.
2. For most clubs, this is the Club Champion from 2020 but for this year (2021) only, the previous Club Champion** who was unable to play due to the cancellation of the 2020 Queen of Clubs Competition may also play.

** Those Club Champions who sent an entry in for the 2020 Competition and received an acknowledgment do not need to re apply - their entry from last year has been retained and they will have automatic entry to the 2021 Queen of Clubs.

3. Regulations:
 - a. Entry Forms accompanied by the appropriate Entry Fee, must reach the Organiser by the closing date.
 - b. The Committee shall consist of a minimum of 3: the Organiser, the Chief Referee and one other host County Committee member.
 - c. In all matters the decision of the Committee is final.
 - d. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning a reason for its decision.
 - e. The Committee reserves the right to arrange and /or alter starting times.
 - f. In the event of adverse conditions the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
 - g. A current Handicap Index must be produced at Registration.
 - h. Competitors should register at the Registration Desk no later than 20 minutes before their tee-off time.
 - i. If the competition is oversubscribed, there will be a waiting list.
 - j. The winner (provided they meet the handicap criteria) will be given exemption into the English Women's Amateur Championship for the following year.
4. Format & Conditions (R&A Rules of Golf Apply):
 - a. The Competition shall be played from the England Golf Tee Markers.
 - b. The Queen of Clubs competition shall consist of 18 holes Stroke Play.
